## Purpose

The purpose of this document is to outline available options for accessing and downloading Magentus eLearning courses.

### Audience

This document is intended to be used by anyone wishing to access / use Magentus eLearning courses.



## **Display requirements**

#### Recommended minimum display size

View eLearning on a monitor set at the minimum recommended resolution or higher. When playing online, maximise your browser to fill the screen. A larger monitor may be required when viewing via LMS.

### Scoring via LMS

Courses contain between three and six exercises. At the end of each exercise, you must answer several questions. The scores for each test add up to the result. Our courses are set to return a pass if you answer 80% or more of the questions correctly, and a failure if you answer fewer than 80% of questions correctly. Because scores are calculated on a variable number of correct answers, the actual percentage that will trigger a pass varies, as shown below.

Number of exercises	Number of test questions	Passing score	Passing percent
3	12	10	83.3
4	16	13	81.3
5	20	16	80
6	24	20	83.3
